This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India and the College is recognized. The next batch of students against increased intake shall be admitted only after obtaining permission of the Central Government.

- 4. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K State) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.
