A Sensitization Programme on the proposed draft B. Pharmacy syllabus, recently released by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, is being organized at **Chebrolu Hanumaiah Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Guntur** in collaboration with the **Education Division** and **Andhra Pradesh State Branch** of **Indian Pharmaceutical Association (IPA)**, and the **Andhra Pradesh State Branch of Association of Pharmaceutical Teachers of India (APTI)**. Pharmacy Council of India invited comments and feedback on this draft syllabus on or before 20th September 2025.

In this context, all Principals of Pharmacy Colleges in Andhra Pradesh are cordially invited to participate in this sensitization programme. The Principals are advised to collect inputs from their respective Institute faculty before attending this programme for further discussion. Two additional delegates per institution at the level of Director or Professor may also attend. The programme is designed to facilitate an in-depth discussion on the draft syllabus and to collectively prepare comments and suggestions for submission to PCI on behalf of the associations.

This programme will feature comprehensive discussions and feasibilities on proposed curriculum changes—such as the integration of Artificial Intelligence, Python programming, research projects, internships, and an enhanced focus on patient-centered care—while also providing a platform for participants to raise queries, share perspectives, and contribute to a structured, collective response.

Participation will be limited to 150 delegates, on a first-come, first-serve basis.

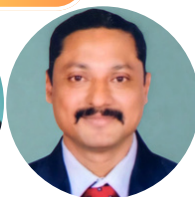
